About the Show

In 2018, our then Drama Instructors, Ciara Ayre and Katrina-Summer Richards wrote an original pantomime about a boy named Ed who got lost in a storybook! They wrote it specifically for TADAA and the students at the time to make it a fun and inclusive experience for all! Back in April 2023, Ciara (now TADAA's Drama teacher) tasked the Finale Drama students with rewriting and reimaging the pantomime that was originally performed 5 years ago! Finale spent 3 months making the script their own, updating the jokes and ensuring there were enough parts for all the current Drama students.

Since September, our Drama students and Denmead Musical Theatre students have been directing and rehearsing the new and improved pantomime, ready to perform for you here today! The original plan was to perform in December but unfortunately that wasn't possible, so our rehearsal time has been a lot shorter than planned but the students have all worked really hard to get it to this point – especially in such a short time frame!

This has been a student-led project and we are so proud of all our students for their hard work and commitment. They also raised an amazing £628.25 for our pantomime by putting on a fundraising event in September which is a brilliant achievement!
